



TIPS FOR BLEED & MARGINS

It is impossible for us to print right up to the edge of a sheet. So if you want printing up to the edge we have to print on oversize paper/card and then trim the sheet to the final size. In order to have an effective print the image must include some extra to be trimmed off. This is called "bleed". Please see the diagrams below.

If your software does not allow for oversize paper we can compensate by enlarging a standard size artwork by about 2%, printing on oversize paper then trimming down to size. Don't forget to increase the quiet area by an extra 2 mm to allow for the enlargement.
